

ELIZABETH W. COLLINS
to
TRUSTEES PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

Know all men by these presents that I, Elizabeth W. Collins, of Collinsville, Madison County and State of Illinois, for myself, and as guardian for Adaline Collins, Catherine Collins, William H. Collins and Elizabeth Collins, infant heirs of the late William B. Collins, of Collinsville, Madison County and State aforesaid, do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns to the trustees of the First Presbyterian Church or Society, in the sum of One Hundred Dollars to which sum well and truly to be paid the said Elizabeth W. Collins for herself, her heirs or assigns, doth covenant and agree with the aforesaid trustees or their successors upon the following conditions towit that should the above named Elizabeth W. Collins, her heirs, executors or assigns for the consideration of Fifty Dollars to her in hand paid the receipt off which is hereby acknowledged, make or cause to be made, a good and sufficient deed, title, or conveyance to a certain tract or parcel of land designated and known as the Collinsville Grave Yard or Burying Ground, situate lying and bounded as follows:

Commencing at the southwest corner of lot number six, in block number six, in the town of Collinsville and run from thence south, twenty one thirty five minutes east, nine chains and 75/100 thence south, sixty eight twenty five north, ten links, and there established the first corner of said Grave Yard and run from thence south, sixty eight twenty five west, five chains thence north, twenty one thirty five east, six chains thence north, sixty eight twenty five east, five chains thence north, twenty one thirty five west, six chains to the place of beginning or said first corner, containing three acres be it less or be it more, to the aforesaid trustees or their successors, then this obligation to cease and become void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.

The aforesaid deed or conveyance to be made and executed on or before the sixth day of September, Eighteen Hundred and Fifty Five. In testimony whereof the said Elizabeth W. Collins have hereunto set her hand and seal this sixth day of September, Eighteen Hundred and Forty Seven.

It is hereby understood that an exception is made in the above bond of that part of the Grave Yard containing the graves of the "Collins Family" extending to the front line of the above described premises which is still to remain in our possession.
